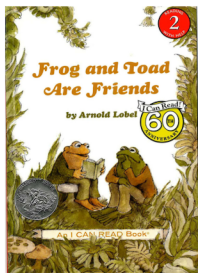

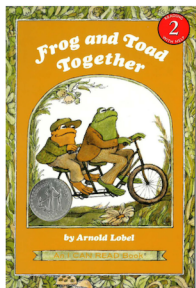
He put the paper in an envelope.
